

1. Ymarfer ffurfio llythrennau/geiriau - yn y tywod, sialc ar yr iard, amrywiol ddeunyddiau, e.e. clai, paent, ewyn gan ddweud y sain bob tro.
2. Bowlio - rholio pêl gan geisio bwrw llythyren benodol. Pa lythyren? (bocsys wedi'u labelu, piniau bowllo plastig.) Yna, symud y piniau gan greu geiriau.
3. Chwarae hercio o un llythyren i'r llall gan ddweud y sain bob tro.
4. Gêmaw Bingo - gan annog y plentyn i ddargopio'r llythyren gan ddweud y sain bob tro.
5. Dis llythrennau/geiriau. Taflu'r dis gan ddweud y sain/gair - ffurfio'r llythyren/gair ar rolyn mawr o bapur.
6. Gêmaw cyfateb - llythyren a llythyren, llythyren a phriflythyren, llun a llun, gair a gair, llun a gair.
7. Bocsys wedi'u labelu â llythyren - postio llythrennau/lluniau sy'n cynnwys y sain – symud y bocsys i greu geiriau.
8. Gêmaw snap/dominos - gan ddweud pob sain/gair.
9. Cawl llythrennau/geiriau – codi llythyren/gair allan o'r sosban. Pa lythyren/air?
10. Cylch hwla hŵps – neidio o un cylch i'r llall gan ddweud y seiniau ar y cerdyn yna neidio o'r cylch olaf gan ddweud y gair.
11. Coginio cacennau bach. Ffurio llythrennau ar y cacennau yna ad-drefnu'r cacennau i greu geiriau.
12. 'Tuff tray'. Cuddio'r llythrennau a geiriau o dan y dail, eira, papur losin a.y.b. yna chwiliota amdanynt a'u darllen.
13. Casglu blociau llythrennau gan adeiladu wal eiriau neu adeiladu trac y trêñ gyda llythrennau ar ddarnau o'r trac.
14. Dawns y llythrennau gan redeg, neidio, sgipio a.y.b. gan ddweud y sain.
15. Darllen y cardiau gan chwiliota am y llythrennau yn y drefn briodol ar arddangosfa yr wyddor.
16. Rhoi llythrennau/geiriau ar gynhwysydd diddorol e.e. welingtons, biniau, bwcedi, potiau blodau, capiau, pocedi ffedogau, poteli plastig, cerrig a.y.b. – eu symud o amgylch i greu geiriau/brawddegau.
17. Apiau addas a chaneuon.

1. Letter/word formation - in the sand, chalk and various materials, e.g clay, paint, foam. Ask the child to say the letter sound while forming the letters.
2. Bowling - roll the ball to hit a specific letter. Place the letters on various labelled boxes or bowling pins. Move the pins to form words.
3. Hop scotch - saying the letter sound as the child lands on a particular letter.
4. Letter Bingo games – encourage the child to trace the letter formation while saying the sound.
5. Throw the dice - what sound/word? then form the letter/word.
6. Pairs - Match letter with letter, letter and capital, picture and picture, word and word, picture and word.
7. Label boxes with letters - post the letter cards in the corresponding box and move the boxes to create words.
8. Snap/dominoes – remember to say the sounds/ read the words.
9. Letter/word soup – spoon a letter/word out from the saucepan. Which letter? What word?
10. Hula hoops – jump from one to the other saying the sounds, then blend the sounds to say the word.
11. Bake fairy cakes. Form a letter on the cakes and move them around to make words.
12. Tuff tray. Hide letters and words under the leaves, snow, sweet wrappings etc. then find them and read.
13. Collect blocks with letters written on them and build a word wall or build a train track with letters on sections of the track.
14. Letter dance – run, jump, skip etc. saying the sound.
15. Read the word cards and find the corresponding letters on the alphabet wall.
16. Place letters/words on interesting containers e.g. wellingtons, bins, buckets, flower pots, caps, apron pockets, plastic bottles, stones etc. – move them around to create words/sentences.
17. Suitable apps and songs.
